



Everyday Theology

'Theology' often becomes a byword for something too rarefied and complicated to grasp, but this is a pity because the Christian tradition offers some rich resources for everyday living.

This module will help participants to explore what it means to be a Christian in today's world, cutting through the jargon to the issues that really matter, such as war, sexuality and death.

No prior knowledge is needed, just an open mind!

The session themes are as follows:

1. What is God anyway?
2. God and the world around us
3. Making Christian traditions – what is a just war?
4. Living as a whole person – what does it mean to be human?
5. The final frontier – illness, death and dying
6. Challenging questions

At the end of the module, participants should have:

- Greater confidence in their ability to make decisions based on their faith;
- Greater knowledge of the resources of the Christian tradition, and where to find them;
- Greater awareness of how to judge what are good and what are bad decisions.
