



Forgotten Books of the New Testament

The Gospels, Acts and the Letters of Paul attract most attention in the New Testament – but what about the other books: the letter to the Hebrews, the letters of James, Peter, John and Jude and the Book of Revelation? This module will explore these often 'forgotten' books, uncovering some of the complexity and variety of Christian faith in its early decades.

Using a variety of styles, this module will encourage participants to read these books and ask whether the variety of belief which they display has implications for the Church today.

- Week 1** Jewish Roots – the letter of James
- Week 2** More Jewish Roots – the letter to the Hebrews
- Week 3** Church in Exile – the letters of Peter and Jude
- Week 4** Community under Attack – the letters of John, Revelation 1-3
- Week 5** The Vision Thing – Revelation 4-21
- Week 6** Should We Remember the Forgotten Books?
