



Unlocking the Story of Your Church

The parish churches of the Church of England are fascinating treasure-chests of faith down the centuries. Whether your church is a historic building or quite recently built, this module will help you to understand the history which has made the building what it is today, and also help you to tell its story, as well as the story of the people who have worshipped in it.

Participants do not need a great deal of previous knowledge. The module will take place over two Saturdays, and there will be the opportunity to find out some of the story of your own church as well as that of St Gregory's, Tredington. Finding out about the story of this church will help you to know what to look for in your own church.

The style of the module is highly participative, including discussion, role-plays, group work and video-clips, alongside more traditional presentation.

The theme of the first day will be ***Finding the Story of Your Church*** and the second will be ***Telling the Story of Your Church***.

By the End of the Course you will have gained the following things:

- Greater confidence in telling the story of your church;
- Wider knowledge of some key resources to help you and others find the story of your church;
- Ability to evaluate how well you can communicate the story of your church to others. .
